



Professional Decision Making with Children and families:

Course Description

This webinar will outline recent research in relation to the participation of children and young people in childcare reviews and child protection conferences.

It will include:

- The background and remit of the study.
- An overview of the perceptions of different groups, Social Workers, IROs and Senior Managers concerning the participation of children and young people.
- Consideration about the barriers and enablers of meaningful participation.
- Messages from children and young people as to how child in care reviews can be changed to make them more positive for young people and ensure young people are more meaningfully involved in decision making about their lives.
